Once again appreciation headlines my message for our congregation. Many people deserve to be recognized for projects that have been completed and are ongoing.

As we begin our month of services at the South Tunbridge Methodist Church, you will all enjoy the sound of a new-to-us organ that was donated by Dale Howe. Dale received this instrument from one of his customers, and provided the transportation to bring it to us. When it arrived Dominick Amodeo, Andrew Rogers, Troy Hoyt, and Mike Howe were on hand to help with the heavy lifting. Dale also took away the two nonfunctioning organs that were taking up space.

The Community House, the white building next to the Methodist Church, is getting a new and long overdue rejuvenation. Ed Howe has spent a great deal of time removing recyclable items and opening up precious floor space. Many of the items that had been stored by the Historical Society are now housed at Kay Jorgensen's. On June 30 a group of volunteers showed up to begin sweeping, washing windows and floors to make the space usable for Sunday School. Plans are underway to have power restored to the building. There are plans developing to have a week-long art program during the last week of July/early August. Stay tuned for more information, as these plans are still being developed.

Work on the church parsonage, or the Parish House is beginning. David Smith and Thornton Hayslett weatherized the front door, secured it on the bottom, and added isulation around it. Panels have been placed over the insulation and are ready for paint. Bids are being received to strip wall paper and prepare the walls, ceilings and woodwork for paint in the downstairs rooms. Contact me if you would like to help reduce the cost of this project. And we are cleaning more trash from the Parish House garage and back rooms. Thanks to Dominick for providing the trailer for hauling it away.
