The DivorceCare Support Group, a series of 13 consecutive weekly meetings will be held in the Tunbridge Church Parish House, beginning Tuesday, September 11 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. Registration is required and there is a \$25 fee for workbooks (scholarships are available for those who cannot afford the fee). Co-sponsored by the Tunbridge and Journey Churches.

Key program components include:

- DivorceCare participants can attend any one of the thirteen weekly sessions when they need to. People affected by Divorce and Separation need help right away.
- DivorceCare is facilitated by a layperson (Robert Brinkley).

- DivorceCare is Christ-centered, with scriptural verses and places to take notes throughout the workbook.
- DivorceCare sessions start with a 30-35 minute DVD showing experts discussing separation and divorce. Next, group participants share their stories and discuss an "On Your Own" assignment for the coming week.
